Lesson Plan		Topic	Choosing a university and course	Year Group	Y10- Y13
Objectives		 By the end of the session students will have thought about which course they would like to study at university. Student will have looked at different criteria to assess if a university suits their personal preference and needs. Students will have completed research on UK universities. 			
New / Keywords		UCAS, student finance, tariff points, UCAS points, joint honours, contact hours, placements, transferable skills, undergraduate, postgraduate.			
Materials		Presentation, worksheet, university prospectuses or internet access.			
Teaching & Learning	Introduction (5 mins)	<u>Icebreaker:</u> Quiz about university (See presentation) Explain to students the volume of courses available within the UK and the world. The session will aim to narrow down their search.			
	Development (40-50 mins)	Act 1: Why university? — Student discuss amount themselves 6 reasons why someone would like to go to university. They can use the spider diagram icons to help them. Go through each reason to give further explanation. Act 2: Picking a Course —Guess the celebrity's course: Ask students if it's what they expected. You course doesn't necessarily have to be your career can provide transferable skills. Discuss ways to figure out which course to complete. —Student complete page 1 of worksheet. Act 3: Picking a University —Discuss 'COLLEGE' criteria. Get students to think outside of simple version. E.g. League Tables could be referring to employment rate and not just the overall university ranking. —Student complete page 2 of worksheet. Act 4: Researching Universities —Student to take a university prospectus or visit a university website and complete the table. Remind students they can order most university prospectuses for free online.			
	Closing (5 mins)	Question Time – Give students time to ask questions about other aspects of university life e.g. make friends. Recap Quiz. Additional resources and useful websites can be found on page 4 of the worksheet.
