






You only write 1 personal statement for all 5 choices. Make sure to **not** state which other universities you are applying to.










**UCAS** scans your personal statement for plagiarism.




Plagiarism is the practice of taking someone else's work or ideas and pretending they are your own. Your personal statement should be written by you.









It is up to you to check your personal statement for spelling and grammar mistakes.





# Writing a personal statement.

He would need to talk about his transferable skills. A skill he can take from one place and apply to another.










