

Letter from your Parent(s)

If you are going to be financially supported by your parents you must provide (in addition to bank statement/ letter), your Birth Certificate (with a professional translation in English) and a letter from them. This letter must be in English or if not, it must be accompanied by a professional English translation.

The letter should confirm the following:

- Their name
- The relationship between you and them
- That they give their consent to the money being used for your education in the UK.

Below is an example of a consent letter. Parents can use this letter to create their own by filling in the blanks in *italics*:
